II. Scientific component of the educational and scientific program

The scientific component of the educational and scientific program involves the postgraduate student conducting his/her own scientific research under the guidance of one or two supervisors and presenting its results in the form of a dissertation. The dissertation for obtaining the degree of Doctor of Philosophy is an independent detailed research that offers a solution to the current scientific and applied task in the specialty 032 «*History and archaeology*», the results of which are characterized by scientific novelty and practical value and are published in relevant publications.

During the implementation of the scientific component of the educational and scientific program and the writing of the dissertation, the graduate student must be guided by the norms of the Regulation "On academic integrity at the National University "Lviv Polytechnic", in particular, to practice a culture of scientific integrity during the implementation of all types of scientific activity, to prevent plagiarism in scientific articles and dissertations.

The scientific component of the educational-scientific program is drawn up in the form of an individual plan of scientific work of a postgraduate student and is an integral part of the postgraduate study plan.

An integral part of the scientific component of the postgraduate educational and scientific program is the preparation and publication of scientific articles, speeches at scientific conferences, scientific professional seminars, round tables, and symposia.

2. Problems of history and archeology of the Ukrainian Middle Ages.
3. Activities of monument protection institutions on Ukrainian lands in the 19th and early 20th centuries.

5. The history of the creation of museums and the formation of collections.
6. Historical and cultural heritage of national communities/minorities.
7. Monuments of totalitarian regimes: from reinterpretation to museification.
8. Local history.
9. History of everyday life.
10. Politics of memory: official discourses and trends of transformation.
11. Intellectual history of modern Ukraine.
12. Public history and cultural heritage.
13. Historical urbanism.
14. Jewish studies.
15. Women's studies: historical dimension.
16. History of the Ukrainian-Polish border.
17. Historical geography of Ukraine.
18. Historical tourism in Ukraine.
19. History of the Church.
20. Religious processes in Ukraine.
21. Ukraine in the First and Second World Wars.

22. History of archival affairs of Ukraine.
23. History of the Ukrainian state idea.
24. History of the Ukrainian diaspora.
25. Social history of Ukrainian lands as part of the Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth in the early modern period.
26. School of historians-archaeologists of Lviv University in historiography.
27. History of Ukrainian science, monument protection activities, museum affairs of the end of the 19th - the first third of the 20th century.
28. History of Ukrainian science, monument protection activities, museum affairs in the Soviet era.

31. Defense objects of urban settlements of Western Ukrainian lands during the late Middle Ages and early modern times.

III. Form of attestation of higher education applicants

Attestation of graduates of the educational and scientific program of the specialty 291 "International relations, public communications and regional studies" is carried out on the basis of an assessment of the level of professional knowledge, abilities and skills by taking a comprehensive exam in the specialty and defending the dissertation work of the Doctor of Philosophy.

Attestation of graduate students must take place in compliance with the provisions of the Regulation "On academic integrity at the Lviv Polytechnic National University", in particular, compliance by all participants of the educational process with generally accepted ethical norms, mutual respect, objective assessment of the knowledge and skills of the graduate student, etc.

The comprehensive exam involves the performance of qualifying tasks in specialty 291 "International Relations, Public Communications and Regional Studies" and determines the level of professional and scientific training of postgraduate graduates. The comprehensive exam program contains mandatory and optional modules. The mandatory module includes modern theoretical concepts and methodological approaches in the field of international relations, mastering the methodology and methods of analytical work in the field of international relations, and the variable module concerns scientific and practical aspects in accordance with the chosen direction of the dissertation work.

Dissertation for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy, specialty 032 «History and archaeology» is an independent, comprehensive study that offers a solution to an actual scientific task in the field of history and archaeology, the results of which are highlighted in relevant scientific publications. The minimum volume of the main text of the dissertation should be at least 6.5-7 author's sheets, designed in accordance with the requirements

established by the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

The defense of the dissertation for the Doctor of Philosophy degree involves assessing the level of theoretical professional training of the applicants in accordance with the curriculum. A mandatory condition for admission to the defense is the successful completion of the graduate student's individual study plan and the successful passing of the comprehensive exam in specialty 032 «History and archaeology».

Candidates of higher education for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy defend their dissertations, as a rule, in a permanent specialized academic council for the relevant specialty, which functions in the higher educational institution where the graduate student was trained. The academic council of a higher educational institution has the right to submit documents to the National Agency for Quality Assurance of Higher Education for the accreditation of a specialized academic council formed for a one-time defense, or to apply to another higher educational institution where a permanent specialized academic council in the relevant specialty operates.
