On February 11, 2026,
the International Round Table on the topic:
"KASIMIR TWARDOWSKI, RATIONALITY AND DEMOCRACY"
will be held



The study of the philosophical legacy of Kasimir Twardowski, the founder of the Lviv-Warsaw School, is relevant in the context of modern ethics, logic and the theory of democracy, namely: how the ideas of language analysis and scientific rigor can strengthen democratic institutions and struggle against disinformation.

Main issues for discussion:

1. Anti-irrationalism of Kasimir Twardowski: the importance of logic and analysis for political activity.
2. Rationality and public discourse: application of the principles of the Lviv-Warsaw School in political communication.
3. Ethics and pedagogy: the contribution of Kasimir Twardowski to the formation of the intellectual and political elite.
4. Rationality and democracy: historical origins and modern challenges in philosophical discourse.

Together with the abstracts, an application must be sent, indicating the full name, place of work, academic degree, academic title, mobile phone and e-mail. Abstracts that do not relate to the issues of the Round Table and are not properly formatted will not be considered.
